



Public Partnership Priorities Consultation

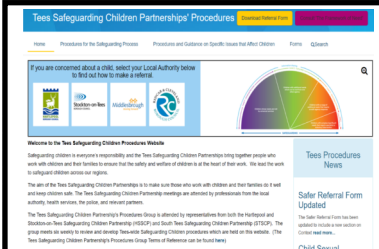

Children, Violence and Vulnerability

The Youth Endowment Fund have published more findings from their Children, Violence and Vulnerability research. The report looks at access to positive activities, youth clubs and trusted adult figures. Amongst others, the report finds that youth clubs are reaching the most vulnerable children, and most children in the study said they had a trusted adult outside the home.
